2021 LUCY'S BLOCK ROSÉ, OKANAGAN VALLEY

Named after our grandmother, Lucy Mary Whitworth, this refined and highly sought-after Rosé is a blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes from our Westpoint Vineyard in Southeast Kelowna.

WINEMAKING

The 2021 vintage was crafted from 75% Pinot Noir and 25% Pinot Meunier grapes which were macerated for two hours before being pressed off and fermented entirely in stainless steel at cool temperatures.

TASTING NOTES

Dry and light-bodied, this year's vintage opens with fragrant aromas of white cherry, strawberry and watermelon. Beautiful, bright acidity develops into flavours of cranberry and cherry.
