WINEMAKER NOTES

Cuvée La Luna displays dark fruit and cassis aromas, with a structured mid-palate, and well-defined tannins, reminiscent of a comforting cherry pie.

This wine is born from the components used to enhance our signature wines, where Zinfandel provides a strong foundation. The unique characteristics found in both Sangiovese and Merlot fill and round out the 'jammy' profile, while Malbec refines the texture.
