WINEMAKER NOTES

2018 began with a cool spring and good rainfall. Moderate summer temperatures brought slow ripening and an extended warm fall meant later flavor development and overall balance. We saw ripe tannins with beautiful color and flavor depth while keeping good structural acidity.

The 2018 vintage was aged 16 months in 15% new French and 85% neutral oak.

TASTING

A varietally distinct wine with notes of dark chocolate and red cherry on the nose. The palate is full of flavor characteristic to Sonoma County including crème de cassis with oak accents.

Enjoy now to 2028.
