## 2019 SONOMA COUNTY ROSÉ

2019 started off cloudy and temperate with steady ripening through summer and a great late-season heat spike. Faced with high winds and dry conditions the winemaking team continued through a combination of collaboration and innovation.

The 2019 vintage was made using a process called Saignée, which involves a short period of skin contact, giving this Rosé its beautiful color and aromatics.



Aromas of pomegranate, fresh cranberry juice and key lime.



On the palate enjoy flavors of candied strawberry, red currant and lemonade. Full of flavor with a touch of minerality this rosé is refreshing with expressive fruitfulness.



Pairs well with Mediterranean - style dishes, charcuterie, cheese, garlic, tomatoes, anchovies, Thai chicken and watermelon salad, or Ratatouille.
