WINEMAKER NOTES

2014 saw continued drought issues which impacted crop levels, but a long growing season with moderate temperatures translated to an early harvest. Summer conditions were fairly uneventful and without extremes, a good thing for grapes. Soft, ripe tannins and intense flavors are the end result. Aged 18 months, 80% in French oak, 20% in Eastern European.

TASTING

This lush, full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon offers fresh notes of blueberry and cinnamon on the nose. Juicy chocolate-covered cherry, espresso bean and warm spice flavors mingle with caramelized oak accents leading to a long, smooth finish.
