Nestled in the breathtaking Okanagan Valley in the southern interior of British Columbia, Quails' Gate Winery is situated on the slopes of Mount Boucherie, an ancient volcano. Our lakefront estate is renowned for producing premium, award-winning wines and providing memorable guest experiences.

A visit to Quails' Gate is both an exploration of the senses and an experience to be savoured. There's a reason we're known as one of the must-see wineries in the region.

Our passion for making great wines is matched only by our dedication to ensuring every visit is a unique and memorable one.

We are an industry leader in viticulture and place significant emphasis on the development of exceptional wines through extensive research of new varietal clones, canopy management techniques and crop control, which is used to significantly reduce yields and concentrate fruit flavours.

We produce ultra-premium BC VQA (Vintner's Quality Alliance) and internationally recognizable wines with a focus on Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

OUR RICH HISTORY

The Quails' Gate estate was established in 1956, but our love affair with the soil dates back to 1908, when Richard Stewart Sr. settled in the area. From working the land, he would go on to establish one of the valley's most successful nurseries. Six decades later, his son, Dick, switched over to growing grapes. With the help of Dick's eldest son Ben, Quails' Gate Winery was founded in 1989.

Over the next three decades, the entire family became involved in making the company one of the leading producers of premium BC VQA wines.

OUR REGION The Okanagan Valley

The Okanagan Valley is situated at the Northern tip of the Sonoran Desert. Framed by mountains and moderated by a series of lakes, this fertile valley is Western Canada's premier grapegrowing region. Distinct soil and climate conditions produce a range of varietals from sun-kissed reds to fresh, crisp whites.

The region is warmer and more arid than Napa Valley, with nearly two hours more sunlight per day during peak growing season. Daytime temperatures reach 104°F (40°C), but the cool nights allow the grapes to maintain their natural acidity – a signature trait in BC wine.

As a fourth-generation Okanagan farming family and third-generation family farming wine business, we've been able to research the best selection of vines for the Okanagan Valley and the best techniques to grow them. This has given the winery some of the most mature vinifera plantings in Canada along with the most extensive selection of mature Dijon Pinot Noir clones.

LEADERS IN SUSTAINABILITY

As industry leaders in sustainability and environmental stewardship, we take seriously our commitment to responsible farming. We have a tradition of using low-impact viticulture practices and our philosophy is to do more with less, employing a holistic ecosystem management approach to grapegrowing.

The Stewart family empowers the team to deliver on exceptional quality and consistency, year over year. This is achieved through farming in small lots with attention to specific blocks, and low intervention winemaking that allows the fruit to speak for itself.

HOLISTIC APPROACH TO VITICULTURE

Our approach to grapegrowing preserves the diversity of our natural surroundings without compromising the quality of the fruit. This includes implementing innovative technologies, utilizing drip irrigation, sowing cover crops and enriching the soil with compost and organic fertilizers.

In April of 2023 we were thrilled to announce our recent estate certification by Sustainable Winegrowing BC, a program that recognizes and encourages environmentally and socially responsible practices in the BC wine industry. This recognition complements our 2022 vineyard certification and makes Quails' Gate the sixth winery in BC to achieve full certification.

RESPONSIBLE WINEMAKING

Sustainability initiatives in winemaking at Quails' Gate range from the warehouse to the bottle. These initiatives include installing LED lighting in our winemaking facility, retrofitting insulation for temperature control, recycling or composting waste and incorporating efficient packaging.

FARM-TO-TABLE AT OLD VINES RESTAURANT

From day one, the culinary team at Old Vines Restaurant have focused in creating menus based on local, sustainable and seasonal ingredients. As the first restaurant in the Okanagan to become fully Green Table certified, the restaurant at Quails' Gate takes sustainability seriously.

NATURE CONSERVANCY OF CANADA PARTNERSHIP

In addition to the environmental initiatives throughout the viticulture, winemaking and business practices at Quails' Gate, we have also partnered with the Nature Conservancy of Canada to protect the delicate ecosystems of our stunning region.

The Stewart Family has committed to a multi-year campaign donating \$75,000 to this important cause and is taking an active role in sharing the message of incorporating environmental stewardship and habitat protection into farming practices.
