Our Plume 2023 Oregon Pinot Noir was crafted in response to an extreme cold weather event in December 2022 in one of our Okanagan Pinot Noir vineyards that impacted our 2023 harvest.

#### FIELD NOTES:

This Pinot Noir is sourced from high-elevation vineyards in Dayton, Oregon—where the cool climate and complex soils create wines of exceptional concentration and elegance. A true representation of the Willamette Valley's rich and storied terroir.

### WINEMAKER NOTES:

This wine showcases a thoughtful selection of Pommard, 667 and 115 clones. Grapes were picked at optimal ripeness and fermented in a combination of large-format wooden casks and stainless steel to enhance complexity and preserve fruit purity. The wine was aged for 16 months in neutral French oak to maintain elegance and varietal expression.

#### TASTING & PAIRING NOTES:

Aromas of black cherry and violet lead to flavours of wild strawberry and earthy undertones, with silky tannins and a balanced finish. Pair with wild mushrooms risotto or duck with cranberry balsamic reduction.
