OUR RICH HISTORY

The Quails' Gate estate was established in 1956, but our love affair with the soil dates back to 1908, when Richard Stewart Sr. settled in the area. From working the land, he would go on to establish one of the valley's most successful nurseries. Six decades later, his son, Dick, switched over to growing grapes. With the help of Dick's eldest son Ben and his wife Ruth, Quails' Gate Winery was founded in 1989.

Over the next three decades, the entire family became involved in making the company one of the leading producers of premium BC VQA wines.

He studied Viticulture and Winemaking in New Zealand where he spent five years before travelling to California to work in the Napa and Sonoma Valleys. 



QUAILS' GATE WINERY CELEBRATES IRISH ROOTS WITH HERITAGE WHISKEY COLLABORATION

Quails' Gate Winery has partnered with Irish Distillers, makers of Green Spot Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey in Ireland, to introduce Green Spot Quails' Gate, a new addition to the Irish Distillers Wine Geese Series.

Joining a prestigious line-up of expressions including Green Spot Château Leoville Barton and Green Spot Chateau Montelena, the series is a celebration of Ireland's historic contribution to the wine world and is a tribute to the group of Irish families known as 'The Wine Geese' who left Ireland and set up wineries around the world. Finished in Quails' Gate Pinot Noir barrels, Green Spot Quails' Gate represents the coming together of two heritage Irish families and the dedication to their craft that inspired this special-edition whiskey.

The Irish roots run deep in the Stewart family, with Richard Stewart Sr. immigrating to Canada from Ireland in 1908 and eventually establishing one of the valley's most successful nurseries. His farming legacy lives on in Quails' Gate Winery which was founded in 1989. Now four generations, three working in wine, the Stewart family has made a name for themselves in wine and now, come full circle, celebrating their roots with this limited-edition collaboration with an Irish heritage brand.

QUAILS' GATE CHARDONNAYS STAND UP TO GLOBAL BENCHMARKS

Quails' Gate Winery hosted a unique event aimed at recognizing the remarkable quality of Okanagan Valley Chardonnay. A panel of esteemed wine journalists and wine professionals were invited to partake in a blind tasting, meticulously evaluating and benchmarking Okanagan Chardonnay from the 2019, 2020 and 2021 vintages against some of the finest examples from around the globe, including Quails' Gate's own Stewart Family Reserve Chardonnay and Rosemary's Block Chardonnay.

The purpose of this tasting was to create an engaging platform for stimulating discussion, reciprocal learning and ultimately putting Okanagan Chardonnay into a global context. The blind tasting comprised three flights designed to represent cool-climate expressions, warm-climate expressions and diverse winemaking styles. Each flight was accompanied by lively discussion moderated by renowned wine critic, Anthony Gismondi enabling participants to delve deep into the intricacies of the wines, share valuable insights and rate the wines based on the 100-point scoring system.

As a relatively young wine region, this experiment provided some great learning for future vintages and helped reveal what our local industry knew all along – that Okanagan Chardonnay can stand up to the best in the world.

We bet early on Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in the Okanagan and we launched the Stewart Family Reserve Chardonnay in 1993. I personally believe that the Okanagan Valley has really come to the forefront in terms of making excellent quality Chardonnay – this classification tasting solidified that."


OUR REGION The Okanagan Valley

The Okanagan Valley is situated at the Northern tip of the Sonoran Desert. Framed by mountains and moderated by a series of lakes, this fertile valley is Western Canada's premier grapegrowing region. Distinct soil and climate conditions produce a range of varietals from sun-kissed reds to fresh, crisp whites.

The region is warmer and more arid than Napa Valley, with nearly two hours more sunlight per day during peak growing season. Daytime temperatures reach 104°F (40°C), but the cool nights allow the grapes to maintain their natural acidity – a signature trait in BC wine.

As a fourth-generation Okanagan farming family and third-generation family farming wine business, we've been able to research the best selection of vines for the Okanagan Valley and the best techniques to grow them. This has given the winery some of the most mature vinifera plantings in Canada along with the most extensive selection of mature Dijon Pinot Noir clones.

LEADERS IN SUSTAINABILITY

As industry leaders in sustainability and environmental stewardship, we take seriously our commitment to responsible farming. We have a tradition of using low-impact viticulture practices and our philosophy is to do more with less, employing a holistic ecosystem management approach to grapegrowing.

The Stewart family empowers the team to deliver on exceptional quality and consistency, year over year. This is achieved through farming in small lots with attention to specific blocks, and low intervention winemaking that allows the fruit to speak for itself.

Environmental stewardship has always been one of the pillars at Quails' Gate. We feel a personal responsibility to protect this land for future generations to enjoy."

HOLISTIC APPROACH TO VITICULTURE

Our approach to grapegrowing preserves the diversity of our natural surroundings without compromising the quality of the fruit. This includes implementing innovative technologies, utilizing drip irrigation, sowing cover crops and enriching the soil with compost and organic fertilizers.

In April of 2023 we were thrilled to announce our recent estate certification by Sustainable Winegrowing BC, a program that recognizes and encourages environmentally and socially responsible practices in the BC wine industry. This recognition complements our 2022 vineyard certification and makes Quails' Gate the sixth winery in BC to achieve full certification.

RESPONSIBLE WINEMAKING

Sustainability initiatives in winemaking at Quails' Gate range from the warehouse to the bottle. These initiatives include installing LED lighting in our winemaking facility, retrofitting insulation for temperature control, recycling or composting waste and incorporating efficient packaging.

FARM-TO-TABLE AT OLD VINES RESTAURANT

From day one, the culinary team at Old Vines Restaurant have focused in creating menus based on local, sustainable and seasonal ingredients. As the first restaurant in the Okanagan to become fully Green Table certified, the restaurant at Quails' Gate takes sustainability seriously. Our focus on freshness and sustainability extends to our Ocean Wise partners and practices.

NATURE CONSERVANCY OF CANADA PARTNERSHIP

In addition to the environmental initiatives throughout the viticulture, winemaking and business practices at Quails' Gate, we have also partnered with the Nature Conservancy of Canada to protect the delicate ecosystems of our stunning region.

The Stewart Family has committed to a multi-year campaign donating \$75,000 to this important cause and is taking an active role in sharing the message of incorporating environmental stewardship and habitat protection into farming practices.
