Named after our Grandmother, Lucy Mary Whitworth, this Rosé is a blend of Pinot Noir (73%) and Pinot Meunier (27%) grapes from our Westpoint Vineyard in South Kelowna.

2022 VINTAGE

Despite a delay to the growing season due to unseasonably cold conditions in early 2022, warm sunny skies and summer heat remained steady to the end of October resulting in a classic vintage for Quails' Gate with exceptional quality across the portfolio.

WINEMAKING

This year's vintage of this forever favourite was hand harvested in early October. The grapes were gently destemmed, crushed and allowed to soak for less than one hour before cold fermenting the free-run juice in stainless steel tanks to retain the wine's fresh fruit aromas and flavours.

TASTING NOTES

The 2022 vintage opens with aromas of wild strawberry, raspberry and cherry. On the palate, bright, fresh flavours of red berries lead to a long, lasting finish.
