2021 began with a dry spring followed by a hot summer which led to an early harvest. The sugars in the fruit developed quickly and the tannins matured nicely. As a result of the summer heat and low water accessibility by the vine, the berries were medium sized with concentrated flavors and a certain freshness which helped create deeply flavored and balanced wines.

WINEMAKER NOTES

A classic summer-sipper that delivers exceptional flavour and value. This year's harvest created concentrated flavors and a certain freshness that helped create deeply flavored and balanced wines. The grapes used for the 2021 vintage underwent a stainless steel production process which resulted in a fresh and fruity rosé.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 vintage exposes a gorgeous pink hue with bright, fresh, red-fruit aromas of strawberry and cranberry. This wine displays an approachable and fruit-forward entry with a smooth finish and enough depth to impress a true connoisseur. Perfect for sharing on the patio, at a picnic or poolside. This wine would be best enjoyed alongside Mediterranean-style dishes, Thai chicken and watermelon salad or a Monte Cristo sandwich.
