



COLLECTOR SERIES 2020 LUCY'S BLOCK ROSÉ

STORY.....

Named after our Grandmother, Lucy Mary Whitworth, this refined, light-bodied dry Rosé is a blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes from our Westpoint Vineyard in East Kelowna.

WINEMAKING.....

This Rosé is crafted with a focus on elegance. Single-vineyard grapes were destemmed, crushed and held in press for just two hours to develop a delicate pink hue before being drained off. The juice was then fermented at cool temperatures in stainless steel tanks to preserve the pure fruit character and aromatic qualities. To add extra complexity and texture the juice was kept in contact with the lees for five months before bottling.

TASTING NOTES.....

Fragrant aromas of strawberry, watermelon, apple blossom, white flower and white cherry. On the palate, a round, rich entry with a juicy mid-palate offering complex notes of strawberry and pomegranate on the finish.

PERFECT PAIRINGS.....

This is such a versatile wine food-wise and is well suited to any al-fresco dining experience. We recommend pairing alongside fresh BC seafood, prosciutto and melon, marinated chicken kebabs or salad Niçoise.
