This vintage was made entirely from clone 115 grown in West Kelowna. The fruit was hand-picked, destemmed, and left to sit on skins for 13 to 16 days before pressing. Once the fermentation was complete, the wine was aged in 28% new French oak and 72% neutral French oak for 15 months.

WINEMAKING

Balanced and sophisticated, this vintage is crafted for the true Pinot Noir lover.
