Our Plume 2024 Rosé of Pinot Noir from Oregon was crafted in response to an extreme cold weather event in January 2024 in our Lucy's Block vineyard that devastated our 2024 harvest. The vineyard has now been replanted.

FIELD NOTES:

This Rosé of Pinot Noir is sourced from an outstanding vineyard in the Ribbon Ridge AVA near Newberg, Oregon. Made from a complex array of Pinot Noir clones, including Pommard 5, Martini, Wadenswil, and Archery Summit ASW2.

WINEMAKER NOTES:

Fruit was selectively hand-harvested to ensure exceptional quality. Once received it was gently whole cluster pressed to guarantee excellence while obtaining color and tannin.

Pristine juice was then cold settled, and slowly fermented at cool temperatures in stainless steel to preserve fresh and vibrant aromatics.

TASTING & PAIRING NOTES:

A fine and elegant profile. Delicate wild strawberry, rose petal, and citrus aromas complement ripe raspberry and white peach flavours, balanced by refreshing acidity. Pair with strawberry, spiced pecan & goat's cheese salad and summer Barbecue classics.
